## **Guest Pass Procedures**

If you are bringing a guest that does not attend Oak Park High School, an approved Guest Pass is due at the time you purchase your dance ticket. Prior to submitting your guest pass to the OPHS assistant principal for approval, you must complete the guest pass including the following:

- 1. Signature of OPHS student and parent (including 18 years old)
- 2. Signature of guest and guest's parent (including 18-20 years old)
- 3. Signature of guest's school administrator (if guest is a high school student)
- 4. Attach a business card of guest's high school administrator
- 5. Attach a copy of guest's photo ID (current school ID of high school student or driver's license)

#### NOTE:

- \*\*Administrator will NOT sign incomplete guest passes
- \*\*Once your Guest Pass is complete, you MUST submit it to the Assistant Principal for approval prior to purchasing your tickets.
- \*\*You are responsible for picking up your Guest Pass Form from the office and bringing it to the Student Store.

## **Ticket Purchasing Information**

- 1. Students and their guests must have "0" hours of discipline in order to be allowed to purchase a ticket.
- 2. Students may only bring one guest.
- 3. The number of tickets to be sold is limited. Therefore, tickets will be sold on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 4. No tickets will be sold after 7th period on the day prior to the event (assuming any tickets remain).

## **Activity / Event Rules**

- 1. Alcohol / Controlled Substance: All school rules are enforced prior to and during the event (whether on or off campus). Any use or possession of alcohol or any other controlled substance during or prior to the event will result in suspension from school, admission to the substance abuse program, dismissal from future activities and / or expulsion from school. Seniors may be removed from the graduation ceremony. Purses and vehicles are subject to inspection and backpacks are not allowed. Drug dogs may be present to assist in searching personal belongings and vehicles.
- Guests: If you are bringing a guest who does not attend Oak Park High School, the guest must complete the guest information on the reverse side. Guest must be in at least the 9th grade and no older than 20 years old unless approved by the OPHS administration. OPHS students will be held responsible for the behavior of their non-OPHS guests.
- 3. Photo ID: Students and guests MUST have a photo ID in their possession at the event.
- 4. Rules: Students and guests must act in accordance with the school event rules regarding dress, conduct and time of arrival / departure. Students and guests who do not conform to the rules of the event or the rules of the school may be asked to leave at any time and the misconduct may be reported to the parents and to the home school of the guest. Law Enforcement will be called when necessary and participation in future school activities may be denied.
- 5. **Breathalyzer / Drug Dog:** There will be a breathalyzer and possibly a drug dog on site for random testing / searching. Any indication of alcohol or other controlled substance will immediately result in a phone call to the parents, removal from the event and future disciplinary action.
- 6. **School Attendance:** Students must attend school the entire day of the event to be eligible to participate. For a weekend event, students must attend the previous day of school.
- 7. Denial of Application: Oak Park High School reserves the right to deny any guest application.
